Vermont's first women's flat track roller derby league continues to support the Minor Catastrophes, Vermont's first girls' junior roller derby team. Each week girls will train with veteran skaters from Green Mountain Roller Derby learning all the basic skills of skating on quad roller skates: skating, stopping, agility, speed and endurance. Girls with skating ability from beginning to advanced can participate.

Note: Required gear: Quad roller skates (not roller blades), knee pads, elbow pads, wrist guards, helmet, mouth guard. All gear must fit snugly and securely. Bring your own water bottle. Girls can purchase gear packages ranging from skates only to full sets of gear; contact EJRP for ordering information. Safety equipment used for skateboarding would be appropriate for this camp.


